## Pharmacy Aid Memoire for the NHSE Pharmacy Hypertension (Blood Pressure) Service and NHSE Pharmacy Oral Contraception Service

This aide memoire is to help your team send the correct patients to pharmacies for the above 2 services. Patients can be formally or informally (i.e. just be told to go to a pharmacy) referred for both services and patients will not need to pay for either of them.

Hypertension (Blood Pressure) – Clinic BP or 24-hour ABPM service Please ask patients you informally refer to let the pharmacy know that they have been sent by you.
