That's why we run Wet Clinics – a safe, welcoming drop-in where you can see a GP about your health, and also speak to a specialist alcohol worker about treatment or ways to cut down.

- Alcohol is permitted on site — we don't expect you to stop drinking to get help
- Our staff are here to support you, whatever your situation
