





AccuRx	Practices may want to use AccuRx system to highlight and supply the NHS Steroid Emergency Card to appropriate patients. Sample text: 'You are currently taking a corticosteroid medicine called [enter]. This is an important medicine but please follow the instructions below: -do not stop taking this steroid medicine abruptly -always carry a steroid card and show to any healthcare professional giving you treatment - download a copy here www.endocrinology.org/media/3873/steroid-card.pdf or contact us to post you one.
