Pharmacy First Aide Memoire - This aide memoire is to help you formally refer the individuals who contact your practice with these conditions.

Community pharmacists can, if appropriate, supply antibiotic etc for the following 7 conditions UTI's, Impetigo, Acute Sore Throat, Shingles, Infected Insect Bite, Acute Sinusitis and Acute Otitis Media in children 1-17.

Locally, most pharmacists can also see individuals who meet the criteria with skin conditions, bacterial eye infections and Otitis Externa as stated below IF PATIENTS DON'T NORMALLY PAY FOR PRESCRIPTIONS THEY WONT PAY
