Safeguarding Codes



The issue of safeguarding codes in Primary Care has been a theme frequently asked of Named GPs. It was recognised by the National Network of Named GPs for Safeguarding (NNNGP) that across the nation there was confusion around which codes to use for different safeguarding situations in view of the variety of options available within the electronic systems. To address this at a national level, in 2021 a group of Named GPs was formed to review current practice.

The group's work involved identifying key safeguarding codes and selecting a single representative code for synonymous codes. Gaps were identified in the existing Snomed codes, so an application was made through the Snomed portal for eighteen new codes to be added into the Snomed system. The new codes were approved and became part of the Snomed catalogue in 2023 and are also now fully incorporated into both Systmone and EMIS.

These safeguarding codes, including the new codes, were then standardised into a single, comprehensive recommended list for all Primary Care staff to use. This Primary Care Safeguarding code list is below, and now serves as a resource for Primary Care Organisations. This unified and updated list will help ensure consistency and accuracy in safeguarding practices across areas, ultimately improving patient care and safety. The code list is also saved in the NNNGP resource area on FutureNHS in the GP IT folder. For those that use Ardens, these codes are now within the Arden's drop down lists.

This list will be reviewed and updated over time by the NNNGP coding, templates and document storage group. Please email england.nnngp@nhs.net if you are a Named GP that wishes to join this group.
